This matter is before the South Carolina Procurement Review Panel (the Panel) for further administrative review pursuant to section 11-35-4410(1)(b) of the Consolidated Procurement Code (the Procurement Code). Renew Data Corporation (Renew Data) has requested the Panel to review the Chief Procurement Officer's (the CPO's) written determination canceling the intended award of a contract to Renew Data prior to performance under Regulation 19-445.2085(C). The Panel convened a hearing to consider Renew Data's request on November 5, 2014. At the Panel's hearing, Carmelo B. Sammataro, Esquire, represented Renew Data; J. Emory Smith, Jr., represented the South Carolina Attorney General's Office; and W. Dixon Robertson, III, Esquire, represented the CPO.

During the course of the hearing, the parties requested a recess so that they could attempt to resolve the dispute. Upon successful negotiation, the parties advised the Panel that the State had agreed to reinstate the intended award to Renew Data, premised on the parties' agreement to negotiated changes to the business terms of the contract. The agreed upon changes were introduced as a hearing exhibit with the consent of all parties. ITMO will prepare a Change Order to the contract incorporating the revised terms. All parties acknowledged to the Panel their consent to this resolution.

Therefore, based on the parties' negotiated settlement, the Panel declines to consider the merits of Renew Data's request and hereby **VACATES** the CPO's written determination cancelling the intended award pursuant to Regulation 19-445.2085(C). S.C. Code of Regulations, Reg. 19-445.2085(C) (2011).
