There are two 1200 ton chillers in the energy plant with one being primary and the second as backup in case of primary failure. Two cooling towers provide condenser cooling water to the chillers. Large unit is 1200 tons and has ample capacity to provide condenser cooling to either chiller. Second cooling tower is only 750 tons and cannot provide required condenser cooling capacity at temperatures above 80 degrees. This project replaces the 750 cooling tower at the Bryan Hospital/Morris Village Energy Center with a 1200 ton unit.
