College of Charleston desires to obtain the services of a Design-Build Team to provide pre-design, design and construction services for the above referenced project. The project requires coordination, expertise or collaboration with a squash court designer or manufacturer. The D-B architect and contractor will need to have experience or indicate how they will engage partners who are experienced in working for a State of South Carolina entity, working within an academic setting and providing completion complaint squash courts.

The project location is the existing racquet sports section of the Johnson Center. This is an entirely interior portion within a combined three building complex (Johnson Center, Silcox PE and Health Building and TD Arena) located on the corner of George and Meeting Streets in downtown Charleston. The site is in the City of Charleston Historic District and on the periphery of the CofC campus. The impacted portion of the building is approximately 6300 square feet. The primary area of construction is accessed through interior portions of these buildings and the overall complex has limited exterior open space.

Adjacent portions of the building will be occupied during construction.

The current buildings have been constructed, remodeled and expanded in multiple phases from 1939 to 2008. The area that will be converted to squash use currently houses mixed use racquet courts with some characteristics similar to squash courts; however demolition of the current courts and annexing an adjacent storage area will be required for the creation of the squash courts. The squash courts will need to conform to World Squash Federation competition standards.

The proposed scope of work includes demolition of existing courts and storage room, temporary partitions and construction of a dedicated squash facility. This new construction entails the creation of five new squash courts, a coaches office, viewing area and replacement of existing storage.

The College of Charleston intends to engage a single contract with a design build team that should incorporate designer, contractor and identify a squash court vendor in order to meet the construction schedule, budget and all regulations for competition squash courts. Investigation of the existing facilities, design and squash court orders can begin at the awarding of the contract. The intention is that all three aspects are coordinated at the outset and consulted throughout the process to ensure smooth progress and that any revisions not compromise squash court requirements. Demolition and site work is expected to begin in March 2017 with construction following. Construction is scheduled to be completed no later than August 2017 for Fall Semester occupancy. The construction budget for the project is in the range of \$400,000.

The College intends to award a single contract based on competitive sealed proposals and RFP response process as authorized by Section 11-35-2910 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended. The Request for Qualifications (RFQ) is the first step in the competitive selection process. The second step includes a Request for Proposals (RFP) and interviews with selected teams. A detailed description of the process is included in the RFQ package.
