Description of Project: The College plans to construct a 31,211 sq ft building in Chester South Carolina. The building will be steel framed construction, the exterior will be brick, split face cmu & stone. The building will contain offices classrooms & shops to support the training efforts of York Technical College.

The facility will be a sustainable design green building which will be certified by the US Green Building Council as a Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design (LEED) building. There will be environmentally friendly materials used in the building which will cause less harm to the earth's resources, forest & will decrease mining operations of the area.

The indoor environment will be clean & virtually free of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) & mold which can lead to a healthy indoor air quality for the occupants.

The building is located on the site to create a south facing major facade to take advantage of solar day lighting & heat gain in the winter. There will be light shelves installed to shade the facade in the summer & reflect light onto the interior ceilings to create indirect lighting. Sunlight will filter into all areas of the building during the sun hours to reduce the artificial lighting & ultimately the heat load.

The heating ventilation & air conditioning (HVAC) system will be a hybrid solar & gas fired boiler.

There will be solar collectors on the roof of the building. The solar heated water will be piped to absorption chillers for air conditioning. The solar collectors will be backed up by a 500,000 BTU gas fired boiler to provide hot water during cloudy days & evening hours. The heating in the building will also be from the solar collector system & backed up by the gas fired boiler.

Water conservation will be employed in the building design such as using native vegetation plantings that can survive with minimal artificial watering. Plans are to capture rainwater, waste water from fountains & sinks known as gray water which will be cleaned, stored & used to flush toilets & used in other applications such as plant watering. External storm water will be cleaned & disposed of in a manner that does not overwhelm the existing streams & not pollute the waterways. There will be rain gardens or wetlands which will capture & slow the storm water runoff before it is dispersed. Part of the water will be used to re-hydrate the land to promote plant growth which produces oxygen.

The College will have a recycling program to ensure minimal waste which would normally end up in the landfill. The majority of the materials used in the building including furniture will be made from recyclable content. The materials will be made from locally produced product as much as possible.

This project is partially funded through the South Carolina Department of Commerce, Community Block Grant Program. The Contract Special Provisions of the South Carolina Community Development Block Grant Program & all Federal Labor Standards, including the Davis Bacon Act, apply to this contract.
