There are small 10 to 15-person classrooms on the front hall of the building which are seldom used because of their size. This classroom renovation consists of a total space of 5,248 sq. ft. The plans are to demo the walls, floor & ceiling of the classrooms, & integrate them into the new addition to create 35 to 40-person classrooms of which the college is in short supply on the campus.

The front entrance of the current building has a structural problem where a metal canopy was removed years ago & the canopy

columns were part of the support of the roof. The added load on each side caused brick to crack & settle on each side of the entrance. The building entrance is not in immediate danger of structural failure. The project will create a new front face for the building & create a new entrance, but most importantly it will eliminate the structural problem.
