SCOPE OF WORK:

This project involves the paving of two roads in the Kimberwick Subdivision located outside of Barnwell (Barnwell County), South Carolina. Kimberwick Drive is approximately 4,174 feet and Pelham Drive is approximately 4,192 feet long. Kimberwick Drive has a split lane entrance into the subdivision. There are two independent lanes 12 ft lanes on Kimberwick Drive from station 0+00 to 2+57.13. This area is bounded by concrete curb. The remainder of Kimberwick Drive and all of Pelham Drive will have an asphalt valley gutter. The total pavement width is 25 ft (two 11 ft driving lanes with two 1.5 ft valley gutters). Tying the valley gutters to the 17 installed catch basins will also be required. Paving of 20 driveways is also included in this project (nominally 12 ft wide, 15 ft long with 10 ft radii). No additional drainage work will be required for this project. Installation of bi-directional raised pavement markers (yellow) and the painting of three STOP bars are included in this project. Traffic management during paving will be the responsibility of the CONTRACTOR. Signage, including construction signage, and erosion control protection will be performed by Barnwell County. The Barnwell County Engineering Office will oversee this project.
