The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the renovation of an existing one-story, 19,715 square foot area pre-engineered building located at 6300 Shakespeare Road in Columbia, SC. Upon completion of the work, the facility will house Richland County's Coroner facility. The existing building is composed of a pre-engineered steel frame structure veneered with masonry on one face and metal panels everywhere else. The roof system is also prefinished metal panels typical of an engineered building. A split system heat pump system will be used for the majority of the spaces with an energy recovery unit providing outside air. Finishes will include, but are not limited to: VCT, ceramic tile, carpet, acoustical ceilings, paint and casework. Other interior work will include basic electrical services, electrical life safety systems, and technology items. An evidence storage area will be incorporated into the building to include CMU wall construction. There will also be infrastructure installed for an owner provided and installed security system.
