The City of Union has been awarded a Community Development Block Grant for the Foster Street Area Sewer Rehabilitation Project. The project entails lining the existing gravity sewer lines with cured-in-place pipe and the manholes will be coated to prevent inflow and infiltration. The work will occur on Foster Street, Woodrow Street, Hamlet Street, Hampton Street, Willow Lane, Knuckles Street, and a 70 linear foot section of Perrin Avenue. The project is being funded in part by the South Carolina Department of Commerce, Grants Administration and is administered by Catawba Regional Council of Governments.

The engineer shall provide the following services: preparation of plans and specifications, contract administration and construction observation at least once per week. The engineer will also complete all U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' required forms and be responsible for all applicable information for the Corps of Engineers and any other regulatory agency.

Proposals for the engineering services must contain and will be evaluated upon the following:
