As a reminder, an approved IT plan is required for IT expenditures greater than \$50,000 for all state agencies. Institutions of higher education are exempt from this requirement. For information, please visit: IT Planning.

The IT Plan is required when submitting a solicitation request to SFAA Division of Procurement Services for any IT-related request and for any COTS IT purchase between \$50,000 and \$100,000.

Admin's Program Management Office (PMO) supports this process by providing an **Agency Relationship Management (ARM) representative** and overseeing the IT Planning Process as well as other tasks listed with: IT Program Management.

If you need assistance with the IT Plan, please reach out to your Agency's internal IT contact and/or your ARM representative.

A copy of the approved IT plan for expenditures above \$50,000 must be attached to the **Solicitation Request Form** (item no. 6) or if you are a non-certified agency making an IT COTS purchase over \$50,000, send a copy of the approved IT plan with the written requests for quote or copy of the SCBO ad, all quotes received, and a draft of the statement of award, to your agency's team lead at OSP.

A3Communications

Our office is conducting a compliance audit of many of our statewide term contracts. At present we are working through an audit of A3Communications.

We are validating that proper pricing was charged to entities as a part of the audit and do not have transparent access to your purchases through SCEIS like we do for state agencies.

We appreciate your response and assistance in the audit process and will keep you informed if any discrepancies are found with purchases made by your entity. Know that future requests for this type of information could be forthcoming for other STCs in an attempt to ensure contract compliance and correct pricing. Ensuring that your entity is not overcharged for supplies, services, and IT is an important part of a compliance audit. It is not possible for us to complete those efforts without your assistance. Teamwork makes the dream work, and we appreciate you making this compliance audit a success.



Tariffs can be challenging to navigate, especially in an environment that is changing rapidly. Because of the continual shifts in fluctuating prices and tariff assessments, we recommend a more fluid approach to handling them. Unfortunately, there is not a cookie-cutter answer and/or way of handling a price adjustment request due to tariff assessment. That being said, there is a helpful

resource that was published by NASPO that serves as a good guide. Navigating Price Fluctuations and Tariffs in Public Procurement - NASPO As noted in the guide, you must first examine your contract to see what it will allow. You then have to validate that the request for price adjustment is valid and justified. You should always reject preemptive price increase requests not based on anticipated tariffs or documented market changes. The NASPO resource offers several options for ways to negotiate price increases and validate supplier requests. Again, how you conduct that market research will vary based on the contract and what it will allow. We would encourage that where appropriate, agencies should consider granting a temporary surcharge over a permanent price increase. When issuing a change order allowing a temporary surcharge, it is also recommended that both parties validate the continued need for the surcharge after a given period of time (recommended 6 months, but no more than annually).



Temporary Personnel Contract – Corporate Staffing – Blocked POs

On June 19, 2025, our office executed a novation for one of the temporary personnel contracts that expired June 14. The Contractor changed their name during the last term of the contract and did not notify our office until their payments were blocked by the CG's office. We've issued a new contract to the same contractor under their new name. So, you will need to process any POs that were locked under the OLD contract number under the NEW contract number. And, of course, all this needs to occur before year-end closeout.

We'll leave the new contract open until July 15 to give everyone sufficient time to process their POs.

The Office of State Procurement (OSP) is seeking input on the following recommendations for new State Term Contracts (STC). Our goal is to put contracts in place that will meet your needs, but we need your input to ensure success.

Propane – Ben Duckenfield (bduckenfield@mmo.sc.gov) is conducting market research for a possible new STC for propane. We'll use this data to help justify the need for the new contract.
