Description of Professional Services Anticipated for Project:

The consultant shall complete a comprehensive visual inspection of the garage to determine the condition of the structure and its principal elements including concrete structures, foundations, drainage systems, stairwells, structural steel, connections, joints, and parking decks noting the extent of structural and other deterioration.

If the Consultant determines additional testing is necessary, the consultant will develop and present to the City a testing plan requiring more than standard visual inspection and non-destructive evaluations. With the City's approval, the consultant will extract concrete cores, order laboratory analyses, and evaluate samples to determine physical conditions.

The inspection should also include visual examination of non-structural elements such as elevators, handrails, signage, lighting, pavements, and operational equipment. The inspection shall also include inspection and evaluation of the electrical and fire suppression systems.
