TIDEWATER BASIN RESTORATION 2018

On/about March 1, 2018; Beam & Associates, Inc. will issue a Bid Package for work to be performed for the City of North Myrtle Beach. The project involves drying, relocation, and removal of dredged material (mud and mud/sand mixture) from the Tidewater Basin, located off Little Neck Road in North Myrtle Beach, SC. The scope of the work for this Project will be as follows: dry the dredged material that is currently stored within the basin and use the dried material to raise/widen the existing inside berms and extend the existing cross-dike; excavate the existing dredged material down to the previous bottom elevation and either remove it from the site or dry it to dike-ready consistency and re-use it to supplement available sand (currently stored within the basin). The dried/mixed material shall then be placed back in the basin to raise the bottom elevation in accordance with the approved Corps of Engineers Restoration Plan. Excess material that is not used for improvements to the basin shall be removed from the site by Contractor and hauled to an approved offsite location. Contractor shall be required to provide, along with his Bid Proposal, the site location for final permanent material disposal.
