This matter is before the Chief Procurement Officer for Construction (CPOC) pursuant to a request from Action Mechanical Contractors, Inc. (Action), under the provisions of §11-35-4210 of the South Carolina Consolidated Procurement Code, for an administrative review on the Building “D” Chiller Replacement bid (“the Project”) for York Technical College (York). Action protests York’s posting of a Notice of Intent to Award a contract to Boiler Masters, Inc. (BMI). Pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. §11-35-4210(4), the CPOC conducted an administrative review. This decision is based on the evidence and applicable law and precedents.

**NATURE OF THE PROTEST**

A copy of Action’s protest is incorporated herein by reference and attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**RELEVANT FACTS**

1. On March 28, 2013, York advertised for bids to construct the project. [Ex. B]
2. The solicitation required each bidder to list on his bid the subcontractor he intended to use to perform the portion of the work requiring a contractor’s license with an Electrical subclassification. [Ex. C]
3. By the time for receipt of bids, York received three bids. [Ex. C]
4. BMI submitted the apparent low bid for the base bid and each of the two alternates. [Ex. C]

5. BMI listed Johnson Controls, Inc., as its Electrical subcontractor. [Ex. C]
6. On April 26, 2013, York posted a Notice of Intent to Award a contract to BMI. [Ex. D]

### DISCUSSION

The Project is chiller replacement project with associated controls and electrical. Because the engineer for the Project estimated the electrical work to exceed 3% of the expected base bid, York required bidders to list the name of the subcontractor they intended to use to perform the electrical work. York did this to comply with the requirements of S.C. Code Ann. § 11-35-3020(b)(i) and (b)(ii) (2011), which require that the solicitation identify, by specialty, those categories of subcontractors who are expected to perform 3% or more of the work and that the bidders list the subcontractor they intend to use for each category so identified. In response to this requirement, BMI listed “Johnson Controls, Inc.,” a properly licensed electrical contractor for the specialty of Electrical. Action protests the award to BMI on the ground that Johnson Controls does not intend to self-perform the work requiring an electrical license but intends to sub-subcontract this work to Electro Services, Inc. (Electro). Therefore, Action requests that BMI’s bid “be rejected as non-responsive” for “listing Johnson Controls as the electrical subcontractor.”

An agency must award a contract only to the lowest responsive bidder. S.C. Code Ann. § 11-35-3020(c)(i). In other words, an agency cannot award to a nonresponsive bidder. A bid is responsive if it “conforms in all material aspects to the invitation for bids” Section 11-35-1410(7). Accordingly, an agency must reject a bid that deviates from any essential solicitation requirements. Section 11-35-1520(13).<sup>1</sup> In the context of the subcontractor-listing requirement of the Procurement Code, “[a] bidder in response to an invitation for bids shall set forth in his bid the name of **only those subcontractors** to perform the work as identified in the invitation for

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<sup>1</sup> If a bid fails to conform and the nonconformance is not material, “[t]he procurement officer shall either give the bidder an opportunity to cure [the nonconformity] or waive any such deficiency when it is to the advantage of the State.” S.C. Code Ann. § 11-35-1520(13). An immaterial nonconformity or “minor informality or irregularity is one which is merely a matter of form or is some immaterial variation from the exact requirements of the invitation for bids.” *Id.* For a thorough discussion of materiality, see *Protest of National Computer Systems, Inc.*, Panel Case No. 1989-13.

bids.” [emphasis added] Section 11-35-3020(b)(i). BMI did just this by providing the name of Johnson Controls. Therefore, BMI’s bid is responsive.

Whether or not Johnson Controls intended to use someone else to perform the work requiring a contractor’s license with an electrical subclassification is irrelevant to the issue of BMI’s

responsiveness. Having listed Johnson Controls as the entity it intends to contract with for the performance of this work, BMI may contract only with Johnson Controls. S.C. Code Ann. §§ 11-35-3020(b)(i) and 3021. However, nothing in the law prohibits Johnson Controls from sub-subcontracting with another entity to perform this work and nothing in the law requires bidders to provide the names of sub-subcontractors that their named subcontractors intend to use.

**DETERMINATION**

BMI, by listing the name of Johnson Controls as the entity it intended to contract with for the performance of the work requiring a contractor’s license with an electrical subclassification, is responsive. Therefore, the protest is denied.

**STATEMENT OF RIGHT TO FURTHER ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW**  
*Protest Appeal Notice (Revised January 2013)*

The South Carolina Procurement Code, in Section 11-35-4210, subsection 6, states:

(6) Finality of Decision. A decision pursuant to subsection (4) is final and conclusive, unless fraudulent or unless a person adversely affected by the decision requests a further administrative review by the Procurement Review Panel pursuant to Section 11-35-4410(1) within ten days of posting of the decision in accordance with subsection (5). The request for review must be directed to the appropriate chief procurement officer, who shall forward the request to the panel or to the Procurement Review Panel, and must be in writing, setting forth the reasons for disagreement with the decision of the appropriate chief procurement officer. The person also may request a hearing before the Procurement Review Panel. The appropriate chief procurement officer and an affected governmental body shall have the opportunity to participate fully in a later review or appeal, administrative or judicial.

**FILE BY CLOSE OF BUSINESS:** Appeals must be filed by 5:00 PM, the close of business. *Protest of Palmetto Unilect, LLC*, Case No. 2004-6 (dismissing as untimely an appeal emailed prior to 5:00 PM but not received until after 5:00 PM); *Appeal of Pee Dee Regional Transportation Services, et al.*, Case No. 2007-1 (dismissing as untimely an appeal faxed to the CPO at 6:59 PM).

**FILING FEE:** Pursuant to Proviso 83.1 of the 2012 General Appropriations Act, "[r]equests for administrative review before the South Carolina Procurement Review Panel shall be accompanied by a filing fee of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00), payable to the SC Procurement Review Panel. The panel is authorized to charge the party requesting an administrative review under the South Carolina Code Sections 11-35-4210(6), 11-35-4220(5), 11-35-4230(6) and/or 11-35-4410...Withdrawal of an appeal will result in the filing fee being forfeited to the panel. If a party desiring to file an appeal is unable to pay the filing fee because of financial hardship, the party shall submit a completed Request for Filing Fee Waiver form at the same time the request for review is filed. The Request for Filing Fee Waiver form is attached to this Decision. If the filing fee is not waived, the party must pay the filing fee within fifteen days of the date of receipt of the order denying waiver of the filing fee. Requests for administrative review will not be accepted unless accompanied by the filing fee or a completed Request for Filing Fee Waiver form at the time of filing." PLEASE MAKE YOUR CHECK PAYABLE TO THE "SC PROCUREMENT REVIEW PANEL."

**LEGAL REPRESENTATION:** In order to prosecute an appeal before the Panel, business entities organized and registered as corporations, limited liability companies, and limited partnerships must be represented by a lawyer. Failure to obtain counsel will result in dismissal of your appeal. *Protest of Lighting Services*, Case No. 2002-10 (Proc. Rev. Panel Nov. 6, 2002) and *Protest of The Kardon Corporation*, Case No. 2002-13 (Proc. Rev. Panel Jan. 31, 2003); and *Protest of PC&C Enterprises, LLC*, Case No. 2012-1 (Proc. Rev. Panel April 2, 2012). However, individuals and those operating as an individual doing business under a trade name may proceed without counsel, if desired.
