## DIGEST

Under a solicitation calling for a unit price contract for linen and laundry services, low bidder's request to correct bid due to mistake is approved where the bidder's mistake is apparent on the face of its bid, and the bid contains clear and convincing evidence of the intended bid price.

## **AUTHORITY**

On August 25, 2022, the Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) received a request to permit a bid correction from the Procurement Officer for Solicitation Number 54000222864, linen and laundry services for SC Department of Mental Health (DMH). [Exhibit A] The CPO conducted an administrative review pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 11-35-1520(7) and Regulation 19-445.2085. This determination is based on the evidence and applicable law and precedents.

## **BACKGROUND**

On May 11, 2022, the Division of Procurement Services (DPS) solicited bids to provide linen and laundry services to DMH. The solicitation provided for unit price bidding with the low bidder to be determined by multiplying the bidders' unit prices by quantities listed on the bid schedule which was a part of the solicitation documents. [Exhibit B] Bidders were required to fill out the bid schedule with their unit prices. [Id.] The bid schedule had embedded formulas which multiplied the unit price times the quantity in total pounds listed in the schedule. Each bidder was to then take the sum of each group of extend bid amounts and enter them into SCEIS online

bidding system. Each bidder was also required to attach their completed bid schedule to its SCEIS bid.

By the deadline for receipt of bid, DPS received two bids, one from Environmental Solution, Inc., DBA Physicians Wear (ESI), and one from ALSCO, Inc. The bid tabulation generated by SCEIS showed ALSCO as the low bidder with a total bid of \$9 for linen and laundry services. [Exhibit C] However, an examination of ALSCO's bid schedule indicated a total bid of \$4,539,897.90. [Exhibit D] The difference between the two was that ALSCO entered its unit price of \$2.25/pound into the four places in the SCEIS online bidding form for entering the extended bid amounts (i.e. sum of all unit prices times the listed quantities for each item description).

The bid tabulation generated by SCEIS showed ESI's total bid at \$436,419.41 for linen and laundry services. [Exhibit C] This amount agreed with the amount shown on ESI's bid schedule. [Exhibit E] Therefore, after using the correct numbers for ALSCO's bid price, ESI was the low bidder.

ALSCO's bid was consistent with current prices paid by DMH for linen and laundry services. The fact that both ALSCO's bid, and the current prices paid by DMH exceeded the prices bid by ESI by more than ten times raised the question of whether there was a mistake in ESI's bid. However, an examination of ESI's bid schedule provided the solution. ESI added an explanation to its bid form which states:

Physicians Wear [ESI] will charge the SCDMH \$1.29 per pound for clean laundry delivered back to CMT and DIS per page 21 paragraph 1.31. The below unit pricing is a reflection of what the break down would be per piece based off the average monthly poundage provided in the bid. Per page 21 pararaph [sic] 1.31 CMT paid an average of 20,662 pounds of clean laundry delivered a month. Using this average for CMT the average monthly bill for CMT would be 20,662 lbs multiplied by \$1.29 per pound for an average month costs of \$26,653 a month on average. DIS paid for an average of 19,975 pounds of clean laundry delivered per month. Using this number DIS would pay on average per month 19,975 lbs multiplied by \$1.29 for an average monthly costs of \$25,767. It is our understanding per the freedom of information act and an intent to award document from the state dated June 29, 2017 that the current vendor was charging \$ 2.90 per pound for clean laundry delivered back to the CMT and DIS facilities at the beginning of the contract and per an email dated November 17,2021 from the Procurement Officer listed on the intent to award dated June 29, 2017, Stephen Pullie the vendor is currently charging \$2.25 per pound on clean linen delivered. Our price per pound is \$0.96 less than the current vendor. If any further clarification is needed for this price per pound or the below unit pricing please call us at the following phone number (803) 807-6175. As a company that is headquatered [sic] in Columbia, S.C. it is our intent to provide the best service at the most cost effective price per pound for the SCDMH. [emphasis supplied]

ESI clearly states on its bid schedule that intended bid price in all cases is a price of \$1.29 per pound and that the unit prices subsequently provided in the bid schedule are estimated per piece

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prices. Thus, where the form provides for a unit of measure of per "pound," ESI substitutes a measure of "per piece" and provides a "per piece" price. This approach skews the extended bid amount downward. For example, where the form provides for a quantity of 237,250 pounds of towels, ESI provides a per towel price of \$0.14. The formula built into the form multiplied the 237,250 pounds time the per piece price of \$0.14 to derive an extended price of \$33,215. Had ESI simply followed instructions and inserted a per pound price, the result would have been a significantly higher extended price.

$$237,250 \text{ lbs. } x \$1.29 = \$306,052.50$$

In this case, the intended bid amount exceeds the extended price on the bid form by 9.2 times the extended price.

ESI entered the sum of these erroneous extended amounts which were based on per piece unit prices into the SCEIS form resulting in an erroneous bid amount on the bid tab. However, if one replaces all of ESI's per piece prices with the per pound price of \$1.29, ESI's total bid becomes \$2,604,151.90. [Exhibit F] After correcting ESI's bid prices, ESI is still the low bidder.

## **DISCUSSION**

S.C. Code Ann. § 11-35-1520(7) provides that:

Correction or withdrawal of inadvertently erroneous bids before or after award, or cancellation and re-award of awards or contracts, after award but before performance, may be permitted in accordance with regulations promulgated by the board. After bid opening, changes in bid prices or other provisions of bids prejudicial to the interest of the State or fair competition must not be permitted. After opening, bids must not be corrected or withdrawn except in accordance with the provisions of this code and the regulations promulgated pursuant to it. Except as otherwise provided by regulation, all decisions to permit the correction or withdrawal of bids, or to cancel awards or contracts, after award but before performance, must be supported by a written determination of appropriateness made by the chief procurement officers or head of a purchasing agency.

Per this provision, correction of a bid after bid opening is permitted in accordance with "regulations promulgated pursuant" to the Consolidated Procurement Code. The following provisions of the Regulations promulgated pursuant to the Consolidated Procurement Code apply to bid correction:

## A. General Procedure.

(1) A bidder or offeror must submit in writing a request to either correct or withdraw a bid to the procurement officer. Each written request must document the fact that the bidder's or offeror's mistake is clearly an error that will cause him substantial loss. All decisions to permit the correction or withdrawal of bids shall be supported by a written determination of appropriateness made by the chief procurement officers or head of a purchasing agency, or the designee of either.

(2) Confirmation of Bid. When the responsible procurement officer knows or has reason to conclude that a mistake may have been made, she should request the bidder to confirm the bid. Situations in which confirmation should be requested include obvious, apparent errors on the face of the bid or a bid unreasonably lower than the other bids submitted. Consistent with R.19-445.2010, -2050C, and -2095C, the responsible procurement officer should only disclose information that is publicly available when confirming a bid. If the bidder asserts a mistake, the bid may be corrected or withdrawn only if allowed by regulation (e.g., R.19-445.2085A and B and R.19-445.2095I(2)(d)).

## B. Correction Creates Low Bid.

To maintain the integrity of the competitive sealed bidding system, a bidder shall not be permitted to correct a bid mistake after bid opening that would cause such bidder to have the low bid unless the mistake is clearly evident from examining the bid document; for example, extension of unit prices or errors in addition.

SC Code Ann Reg. 19-445.2085(A) & (B).

For the reason set forth above, ESI's mistake in the preparation of its bid and ESI's intended bid price are both evident of the face of ESI's bid schedule.

Regulation 19-445.2085(B) allows a downward correction in a bid after opening that will displace a low bidder by making a high bidder the low bidder provided "the mistake is clearly evident from examining the bid document." The Procurement Review Panel has, in fact, affirmed such a correction. *Protest of Transportation Management Services, Inc.*, Panel Case No. 2000-2. The South Carolina Supreme Court, interpreting essentially identical provisions in a school district code, allowed a low bidder to correct its bid upward. *Martin Engineering, Inc. v. Lexington County School District One*, 365 S.C. 1, 615 S.E.2d 110 (2005). The Court allowed the correction even though the mistake was not clearly evident from examining the bid document. It found the requirement that the error be apparent from the face of the bid did not apply "where the bid correction does not cause the bidder to have the low bid." In this case, the requested correction will not make ESI the low bidder; and its error is apparent from the face of the bid. Clearly if a high bidder may correct its bid to make it the low bidder when the "the mistake is clearly evident from examining the bid document," then a low bidder is allowed to make an upward correction in its bid under the same circumstances.

For the foregoing reasons, the CPO hereby determines that it is appropriate to allow ESI to correct its erroneous bid to insert a unit price of \$1.29 per pound in each place on the bid schedule for inserting a unit price.

## STATEMENT OF RIGHT TO FURTHER ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

Written Determinations Appeal Notice (Revised May 2020)

The South Carolina Procurement Code, in Section 11-35-4410, subsection (1)(b), states:

(1) Creation. There is hereby created the South Carolina Procurement Review Panel which shall be charged with the responsibility to review and determine de novo: (b) requests for review of other *written determinations*, decisions, *policies, and procedures* arising from or concerning the procurement of supplies, services, information technology, or construction procured in accordance with the provisions of this code and the ensuing regulations; except that a matter which could have been brought before the chief procurement officers in a timely and appropriate manner pursuant to Sections 11-35-4210, 11-35-4220, or 11-35-4230, but was not, must not be the subject of review under this paragraph. Requests for review pursuant to this paragraph must be submitted to the Procurement Review Panel in writing, setting forth the grounds, within fifteen days of the date of the written determinations, decisions, policies, and procedures.

(Emphasis added.) See generally Protest of Three Rivers Solid Waste Authority by Chambers Development Co., Inc., Case Nos. 1996-4 & 1996-5, Protest of Charleston County School District, Case No. 1985-5, Charleston County School Dist. v. Leatherman, 295 S.C. 264, 368 S.E.2d 76 (Ct.App.1988).

If a party desiring to file an appeal is unable to pay the filing fee because of financial hardship, the party shall submit a completed Request for Filing Fee Waiver form at the same time the request for review is filed. [The Request for Filing Fee Waiver form is attached to this Decision.] If the filing fee is not waived, the party must pay the filing fee within fifteen days of the date of receipt of the order denying waiver of the filing fee. Requests for administrative review will not be accepted unless accompanied by the filing fee or a completed Request for Filing Fee Waiver form at the time of filing." PLEASE MAKE YOUR CHECK PAYABLE TO THE "SC PROCUREMENT REVIEW PANEL."

LEGAL REPRESENTATION: In order to prosecute an appeal before the Panel, business entities organized and registered as corporations, limited liability companies, and limited partnerships must be represented by a lawyer. Failure to obtain counsel will result in dismissal of your appeal. *Protest of Lighting Services*, Case No. 2002-10 (Proc. Rev. Panel Nov. 6, 2002) and *Protest of The Kardon Corporation*, Case No. 2002-13 (Proc. Rev. Panel Jan. 31, 2003); and *Protest of PC&C Enterprises, LLC*, Case No. 2012-1 (Proc. Rev. Panel April 2, 2012). However, individuals and those operating as an individual doing business under a trade name may proceed without counsel, if desired.
