State University (SCSU) is seek-

Research & Conference Center

The total project, excluding a
parking garage, is anticipated to
be approximately 190,000 square
feet. This includes the Phase 1
components as listed above, the
Administration Building (East
Wing), the Laboratory Building
Wing, The Conference Center
West Wing, & the Conference
Center East Wing (Executive
Guest Quarters).

The parking garage would add an
additional 290,000 square feet.

This advertisement is for Phases

The Construction Manager Advi-
sor services are being sought for
both design & construction over-
sight. The firm selected will assist
the SCSU Project Manager for
the Transportation Center.

A Construction Manager Advisor
is an entity, which may be an or-
ganization, team of organizations,
or individual, with the expertise &
resources to provide construction
management services. This entity
will be working for a fee for the
project owner. The manager's du-
ties are to supervise & coordinate
the work of design professionals,
sole prime or multiple prime con-
